Johnny Autin trained in contemporary dance at the National Conservatoire in Paris. He is Artistic Director of Autin Dance Theatre and Puppetry Director for *Tales from Acorn Wood* (UK tours 2022–2023) and the Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games Opening Ceremony. With over 20 years' experience, Johnny is an award-winning choreographer and dance leader, known for multidisciplinary work across professional, community, and educational settings. He has been commissioned by international organisations including British Council, Dance Hub Birmingham, and Muda Africa. He is Associate Dance Artist at Midlands Arts Centre (MAC) and a trustee of Dancefest, using dance to inspire, educate,

Jamie Higgins is a professional aerial dancer with over a decade of experience in the circus and dance industry. Jamie trained as a dancer, and then an aerialist and has found the marriage between these two art forms to be highly complimentary. After graduating London Contemporary Dance School (2008), Jamie has spent the last 15 years performing all around the world, his expertise have given him the chance to perform at The Royal Opera House, Bregenz Opera house, Opera de Lille, performing with some amazing companies, Gravity & Levity, Fidgetfeet, Levantes Dance Theatre, and performing in shows such as The Olympics, The Commonwealth Games, Bear Grylls arena tour (Endeavour).

Hauk Pattison is a multidisciplinary performer whose career spans theatre, circus, dance, TV, and film. He went on to graduate from the National Centre for Circus Arts in 2014, specialising in Chinese pole. Throughout his career Hauk's contributions to productions often go beyond performance -he frequently collaborates in co-devising and direction, drawing on a diverse range of life experiences including multiple martial arts, scuba diving, and rock climbing. These disciplines inform his creative process and physical storytelling, enriching the development of characters and scenes. His work includes performances with the National

They first discovered dance through a Balletboyz workshop at school, where the blend of athleticism and artistry immediately captivated them. Mitchell trained at Trinity Laban and later completed a placement with Motionhouse during their time at Northern School of Contemporary Dance. Professional credits include Motionhouse, Southpaw Dance Company, and performances for Burberry at London Fashion Week. Passionate about both performance and education, Mitchell has led and assisted classes for a wide age range. Dance continues to be a grounding and empowering force throughout their life and creative journey.

Naissa has also recently movement directed for Piss Carnation at the Soho Theatre, and for Azadi.mp3's music video 'Control'.


